## Guidelines for Poster Presenters

We know that for many of us attending virtual conferences adds a layer of uncertainty. This guide is aimed to help reduce uncertainty and help you navigate your day as a presenter.

- Your poster will be posted to the interactive program so attendees can view your digital poster in the days leading up to the conference.
- Each poster session will meet via Zoom
- On the [interactive program](#) click the dropdown for your poster session "join session" 15 minutes prior to your session start time so you can move into your breakout room and test/ share screen
- Navigate to the "breakouts" in the list and find yours, All breakouts are listed "poster #. Corresponding author last name. Poster title"
- You are not preassigned and can move yourself into your breakout, check your video is on and you are not muted.
- In each Zoom poster session, one "DCHC Staff" member will be in the main room able to help you if needed and help attendees find your room, or answer any questions during your session.
- You will be able to share your screen during your session to showcase your poster if you would like.
- Attendees will hopefully drop in and out of breakouts
- Once your session has concluded you may exit the Zoom session.
