Guidelines for Paper Presentations

We know that for many of us attending virtual conferences adds a layer of uncertainty. This guide is aimed to help reduce uncertainty and help you navigate your day as a presenter.

- Each paper/panel session will meet via a Zoom meeting link that will be posted on the [interactive program](#)
- On the interactive program you (and/or any registered co-authors) will click the dropdown for your panel/paper session
- We ask you click "join session" 15 minutes prior to your session start time so the moderator can verify you have sharing permissions if you need them/ discuss order
- Each session will have a moderator. Your moderator did receive your abstract and your contact information from DCHC.
- In each session, one of our DCHC staff will aid the moderator, monitor the chat, and help manage any issues that arise.
- If you are using visual aids, you will have the option to share your screen during your presentation. Please have visual aids cued up before your presentation begins. The moderator will inform you when it is time to share your screen.
- You will have approximately 10 minutes for your presentation, and 5 minutes for Q&A.
